

San Francisco
August 29 1937

Dear Mother & Dad,

We got into San Francisco yesterday afternoon about three thirty. We crossed the Golden Gate bridge, drove along Bay Shore drive and saw ocean liners going out. After driving for some time we stopped and asked for information on cabins. In order to get cabins we had to drive way across the city. That wasn't the worst part for after we came to the Calia district all cabins were filled. One place we stopped had one for \$4. We ended up in a one dollar cabin, but what a place. (Cabin was in San Bruno)

This morning we drove back to San Francisco and really went high-brow. We have a \$4 cabin which is strictly modern. It is just like a furnished apartment with, kitchen, shower, two beds, dining room and garage. Right now we are all cleaning up to go around town. I don't know how we will make out but we are planning on see D.F. today and drive to L.A. tomorrow.

Are we ever having a time with our eats. Aunt Edith feeds us so much that now it is quite a let-down. We try to buy one good meal a day but that one isn't always so good. Cabins are hard to find. If you do find them they are very high priced or they aren't very good. Ken hasn't liked the cabins we have had

for the last two nights. We (Don, Jerry & I) could get along with most any thing but if they don't suit Ken he is ready to leave early. Otherwise he wants to sleep. He even wanted to go to a hotel last night but that would have cost us plenty. This cabin is the ^{last} one we will have of its kind. The only reason we got it was to be able to clean up.

We would have been here Friday night if we had left out the trip up the Columbia R. The drive up to the Bonneville Dam was beautiful but the dam was a disappointment. To me it isn't as great as The Keokuk we saw last year.

I certainly would have liked to spend more time with Uncle George. However I think it is better that we left when we did. Dorothy & Jane thought we were going to be there for a week or more. Everything we did there I certainly enjoyed. Maybe it was because of the company I don't know.

We have a problem with our packing. I don't know what we will do with our laundry. I suggested we pack all of it in Ken's trunk and ship it back. I don't know if we will do it or not. We were supplied with pillows in Tacoma.
