We attended class today but didn't accomplish much. Mainly had informal discussions on Navy topics. Tomorrow we have no class, but I've heard rumors of a ten mile hike.

I was relieved this afternoon when they posted Friday's watch schedule. I'm on it. I was so afraid that I would get a weekend watch. I'm the asst. mate on the fourth deck of Spear Hall. I don't anticipate much excitement up there. Anyway I should have nothing to interfere with the weekend. However, the same thing could happen to me that happened to Jerry last weekend. Wasn't that awful? But that's the way in these types of organizations.

Mary is going to bring H.B. down to Chicago sometime but I think I'm going to discourage that until the weather is more certain. Mary sent some recent pictures of H.B. that I just think are wonderful.

Pay day Friday - we draw \$43¹⁶ and have to pay \$37⁵⁰ on our independent's uniform. Not much left but I still have all the money I need.
