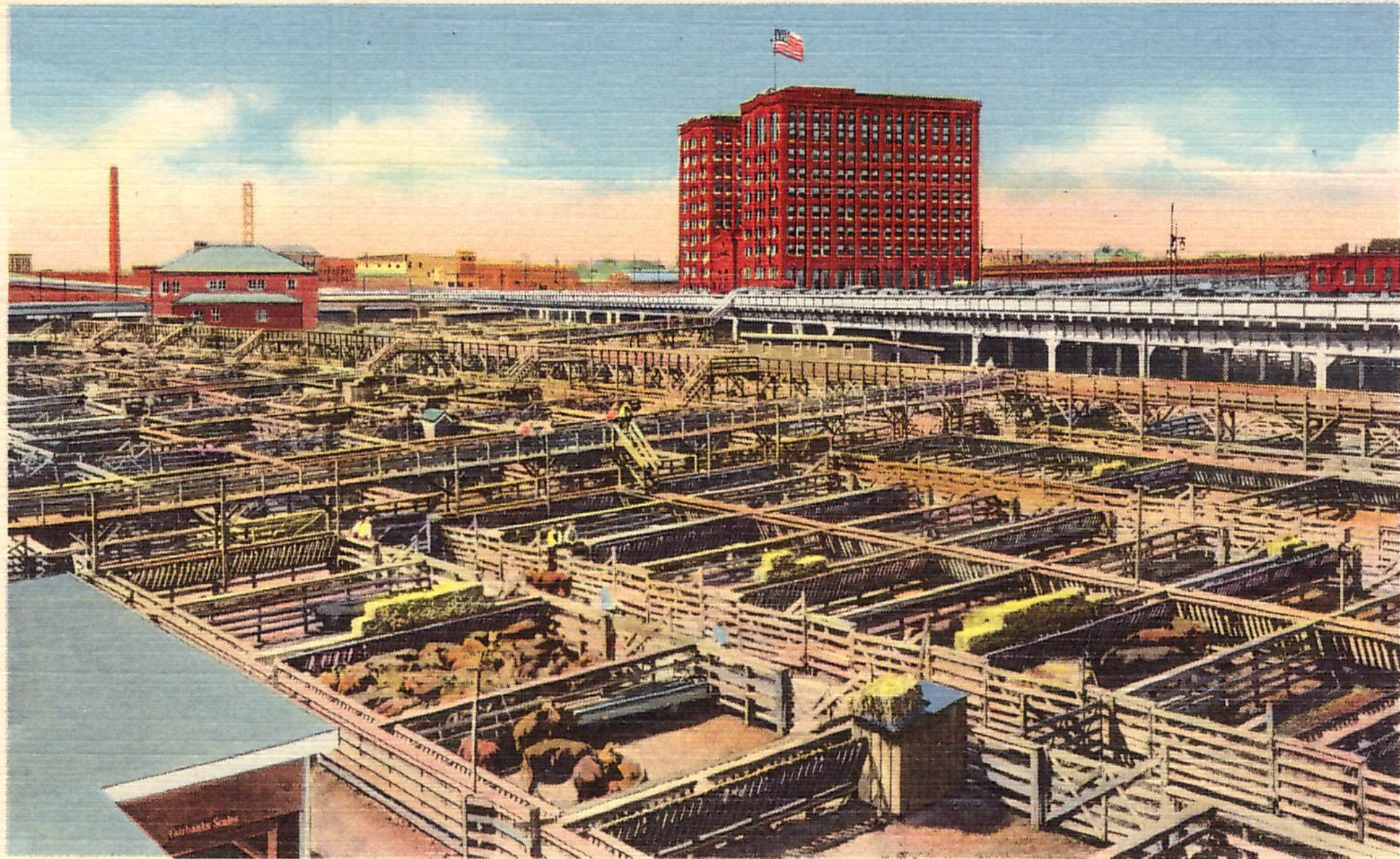


Union Stock Yards, Showing Exchange Building, Omaha, Neb.
