PLEASE NOTE that if you pickup your car at the airport, you will pay an additional 11.11%. plus \$ 6:50 per day (ACFC) in airport taxes and fees. In order to take advantage of the lower taxes and fees charged at the off-airport site office on Spenard Road, clients must take a taxi to the Spenard Office from the airport to pick-up their car.
