Opera strikes balance in 'Bruschino'

Spring season opens with energetic farce

Gioachino Rossini's "Il signor Brus-Gloachino Rossini's "Il signof Brus-chino," which opens the Sarasota Op-era's spring season, is an energetic farce that kept its balance under unusual cir-cumstances during Friday's opening performance.

For the first time in 52 years, artistic director and conductor Victor DeRenzi was unable to take the podium. The au-dience was assured that DeRenzi, who

dience was assured that Dekenzi, who recently marked his 800th performance with the company, will be back to con-duct next week. It would be the greatest compliment to Dekenzi to note that the performance continued without a hitch. Under the di-rection of assistant conductor Gooffrou rection of assistant conductor Geoffrey Loff, making his Sarasota debut this season, the orchestra sounded as pol-

season, the orchestra sounded as pol-ished as usual with notable solos from both English and French horns. The singers, most of whom are veter-ans of Sarasota Opera seasons past, carry out their roles with consummate skill pointing to the fact that the largest share of uwork for both conductor and share of work for both conductor and stage director is done prior to the first performance

Stephanie Sundine has always Stephanie Sundine has always shown great skill directing large farces and plenty of action on stage. The small cast of "Bruschino" has its own chal-lenges twisting and turning around the deception plotted by lovers Florville (Christopher Bozeka) and Sofia (Hanna Brammer).

Both Bozeka and Brammer have Both Bozeka and Brammer have voices well suited to the lyric beauty of Rossini's smooth bel canto style. The two were paired in "Linganno felice" earlier in the season and sing well to-gether. While de Peppo's char-acter has his comedic flair, it is a straight role in comparison to Alexander Boyd's crotchety, complaining and quite direct Bruschino.

It is great fun watching the two mu-sically and comedically duel over the sically and comedically duel over the identity of Florville posing as the young-er Bruschino. unravel it. The lovely Sofia sings persuasively to the elder Bruschino in a spectacular aria that ranges from sweet pleading to in-creasing coloratura emphasis. It shows a glimpse of Brammer's vocal artistry, but our audiences have heard her excel

but our audiences nave neard ner excel under much greater demands. Although this little farce is an early work for Rossini, his full ensemble scenes show his quick mastery of the quartets and quintets that would become a mainstay of Romantic era opera Only here, where multiple moving parts are battling and pulling at each other, we hear hints of instability. While nothing ran off the rails, there was a sense of

synchronicity teetering on the edge, which added to the thrill. The entertaining production proves what a great team DeRenzi has assembled.
